

# OC FUTSAL RULES – AMMENDMENT

---

The rules shall be followed by each participating team, and will be enforced by the referee in each futsal match. Generally these rules follow US Futsal rules, and will bring consistency to teams that may participate in other futsal events during the year.

OC Futsal's Youth Spring League is designed to teach kids the sport of futsal, and allow kids to develop skills in a FUN way. For that reason, OC Futsal has determined that some of the current rules should be modified. The rules listed below are changes to existing rules, and will be enforced during our Youth Spring League.

1. Games are 50 minutes with (2) 25 minute halves. The clock is continuous for 25 minutes each half, and will allow 2 minutes for half time.
2. The goalkeeper may not throw the ball past half line without the ball first touching the court in his/her own half first, or the ball touching any player while in same half of court as the goalkeeper who threw the ball.
3. Kick Ins - Once the ball goes out of bounds, the team restarting with a kick-in will have 4 seconds to put the ball back into play. This is signaled by the referee with his hand in the air. In certain cases when the ball cannot be recovered in 4 seconds, the referee may allow time to recover the ball. Once the ball is recovered, the team will have 4 seconds to put it back into play. This is at the sole discretion of the referee.
